Hello Arcade Phalen Post 577 Family,

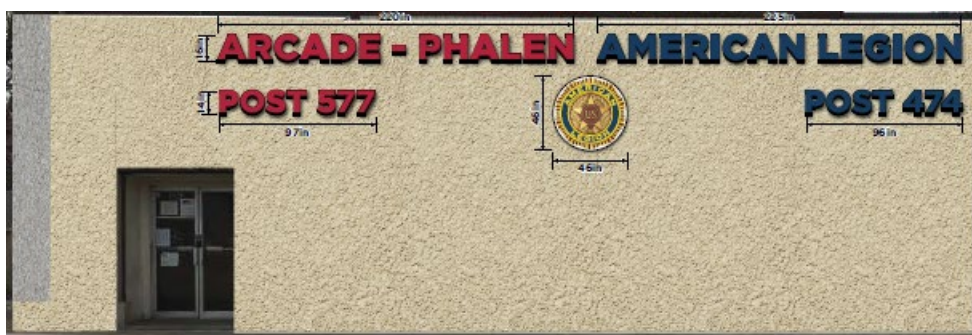
